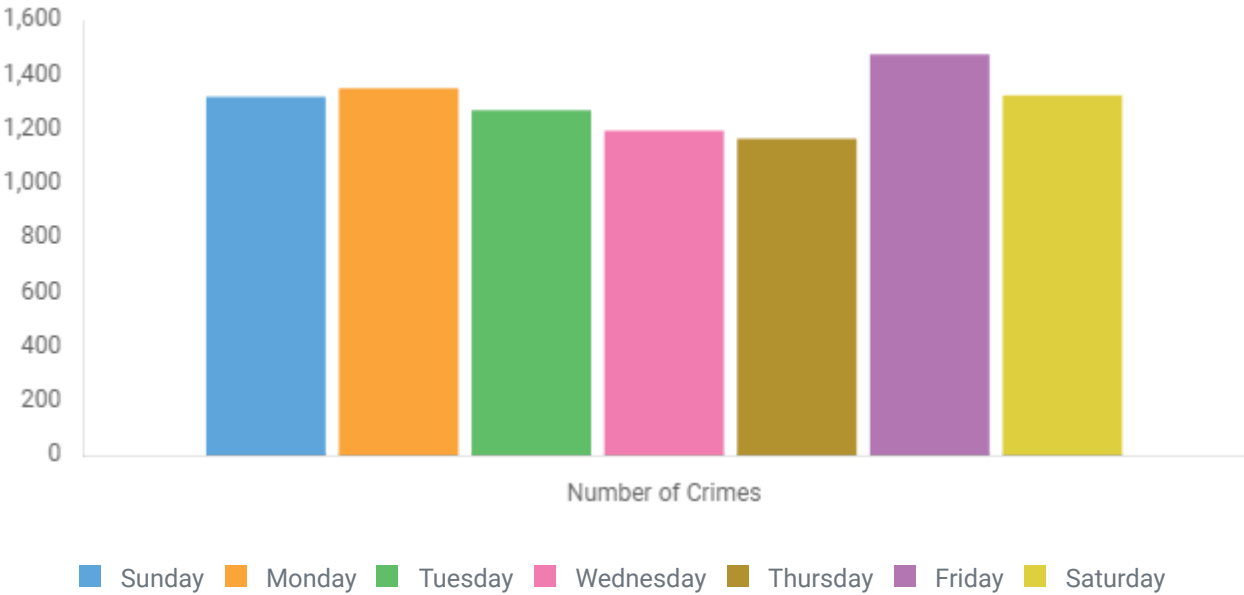

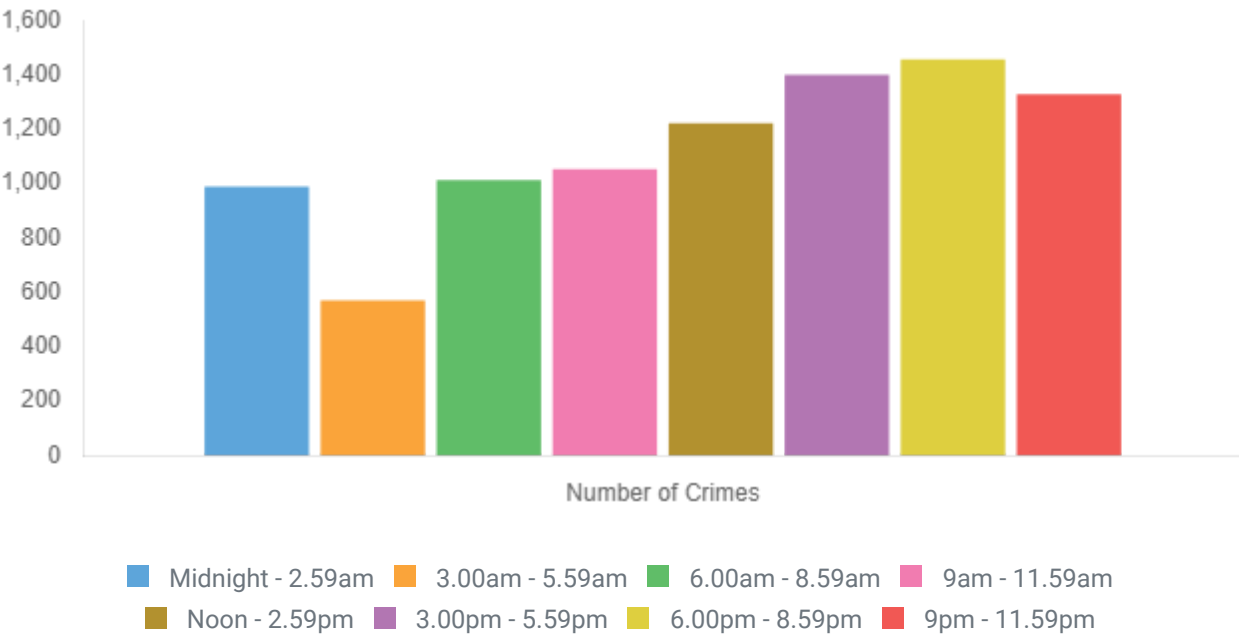
MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT (MVT)

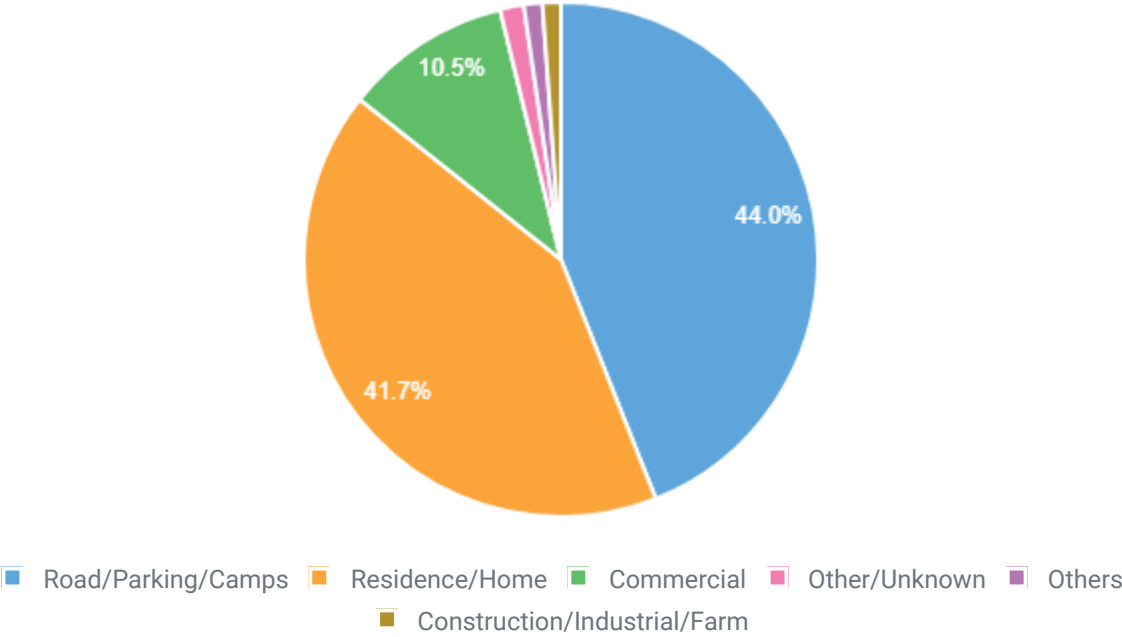
MVT BY DAY OF THE WEEK



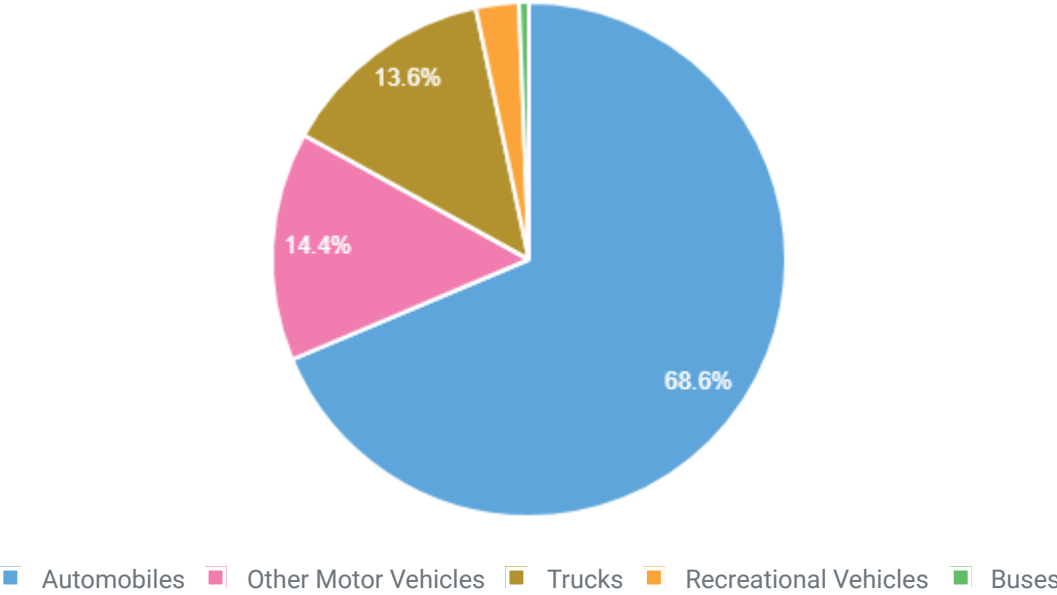
MVT BY HOUR OF THE DAY



MVT BY LOCATION TYPE

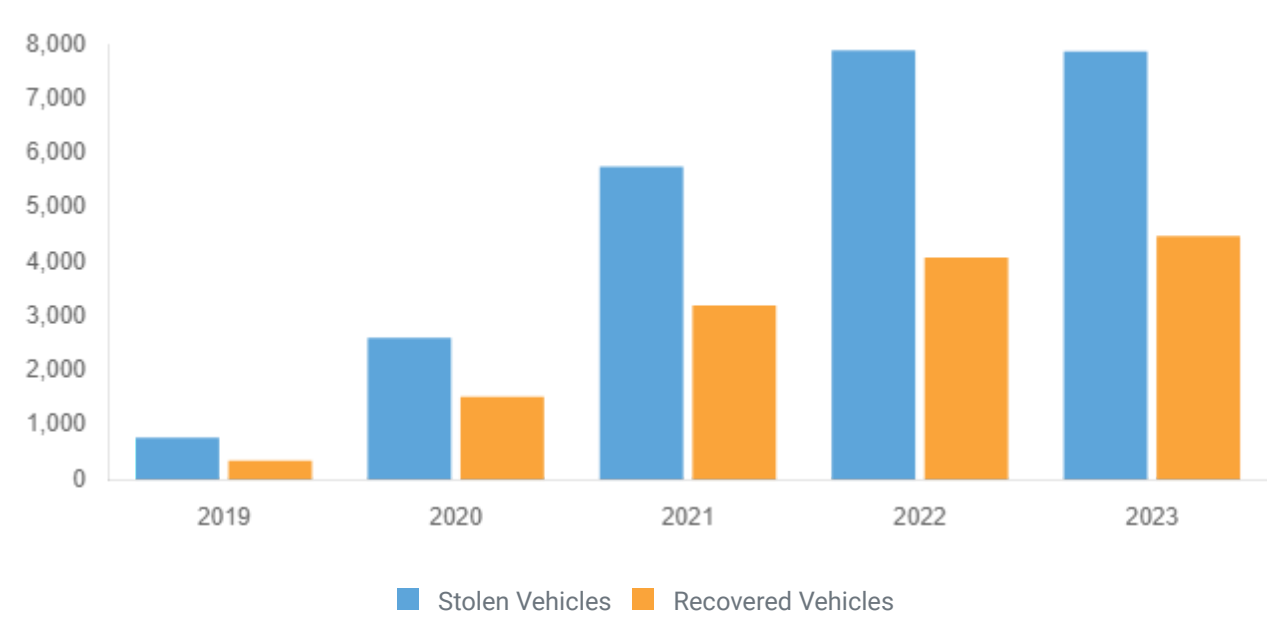


MVT BY VEHICLE TYPE



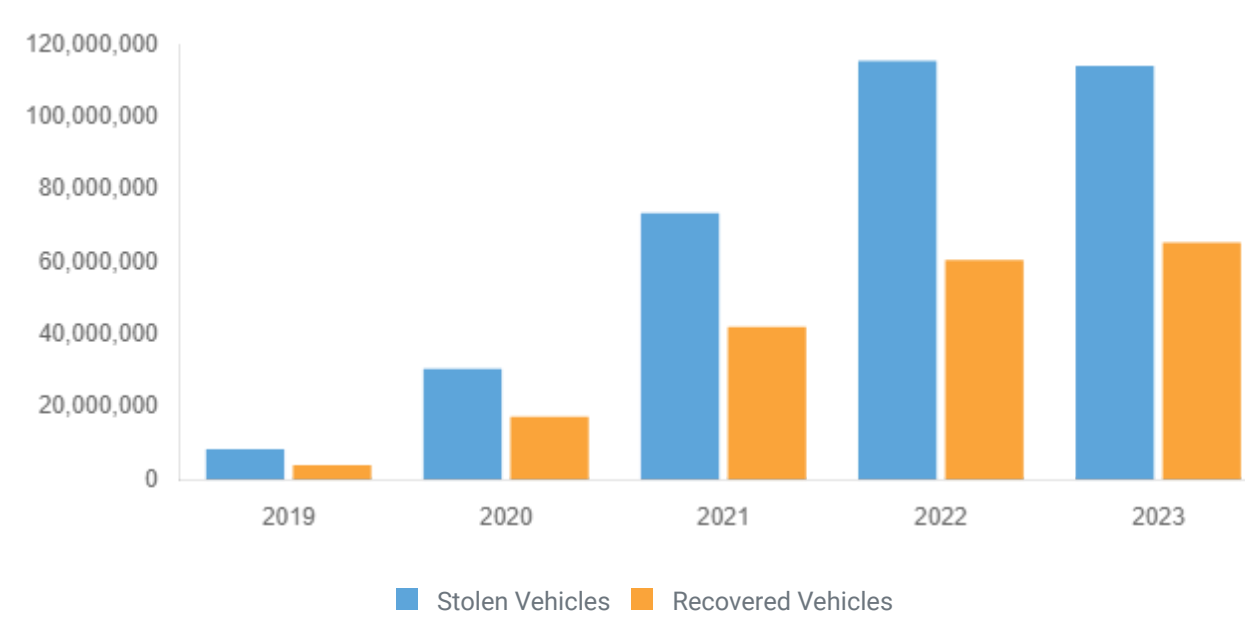
MOTOR VEHICLES STOLEN/RECOVERED

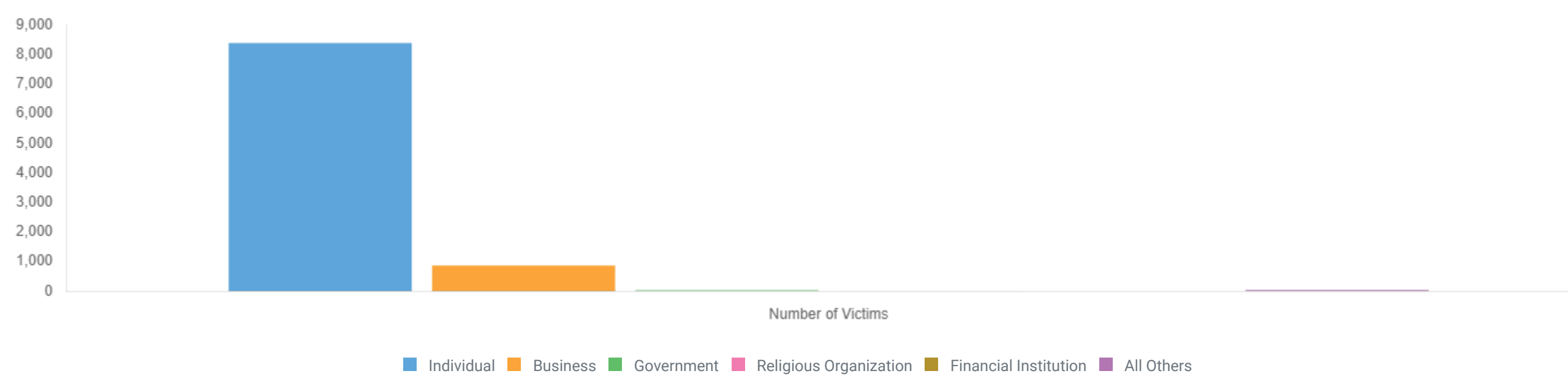


VALUE OF STOLEN/RECOVERED MOTOR VEHICLES

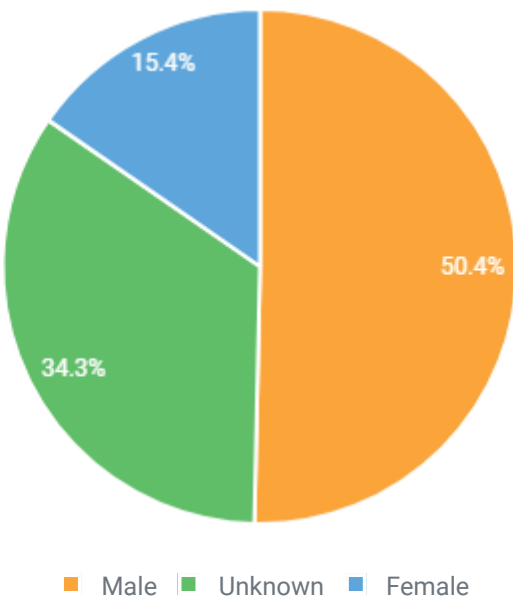


MVT BY VICTIM TYPE



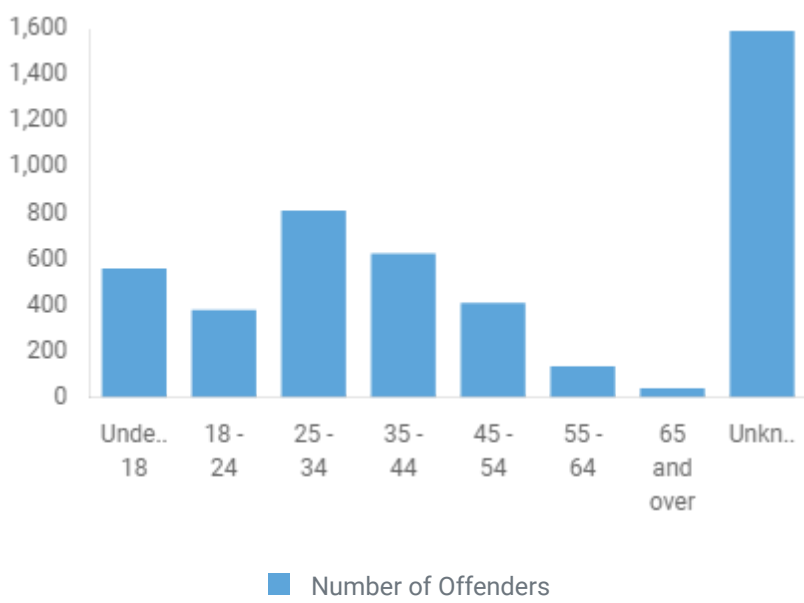
MVT BY OFFENDER SEX

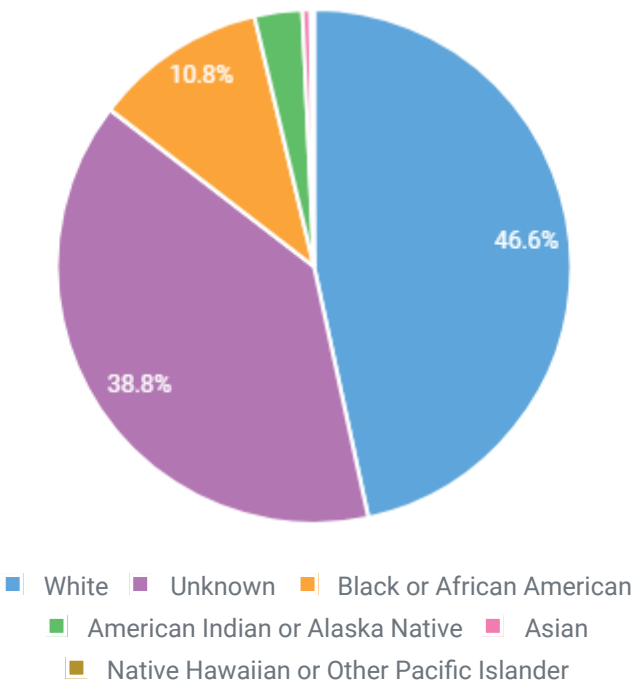
MVT BY OFFENDER AGE
