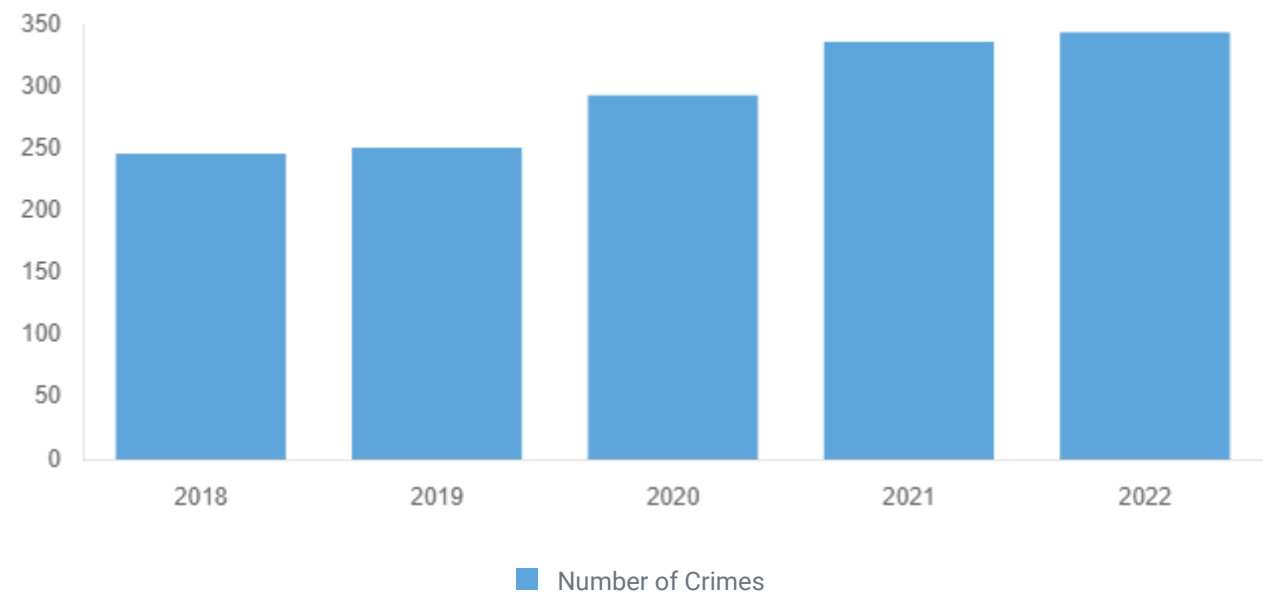

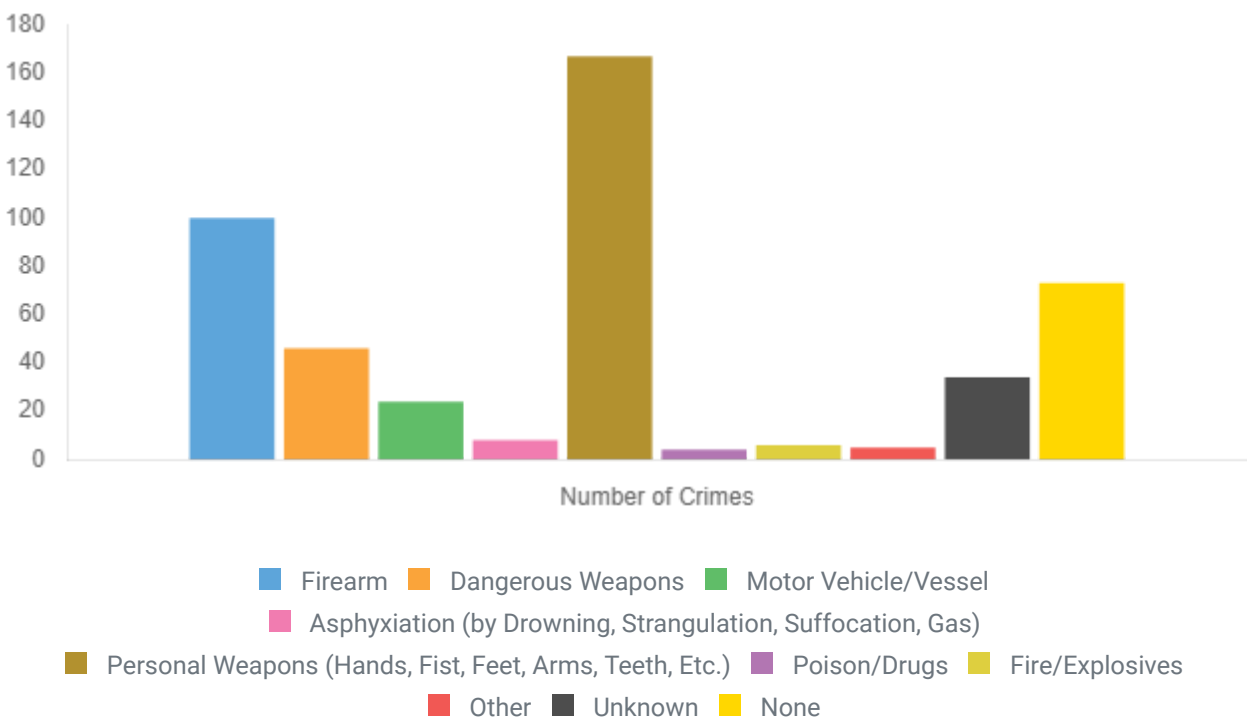
5-YEAR TREND

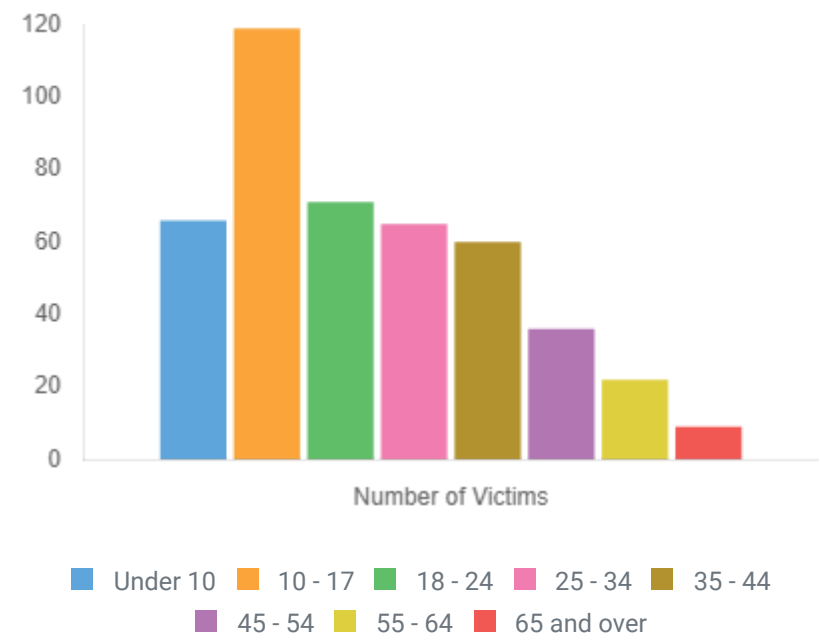
VIOLENT CRIME BY WEAPON TYPE

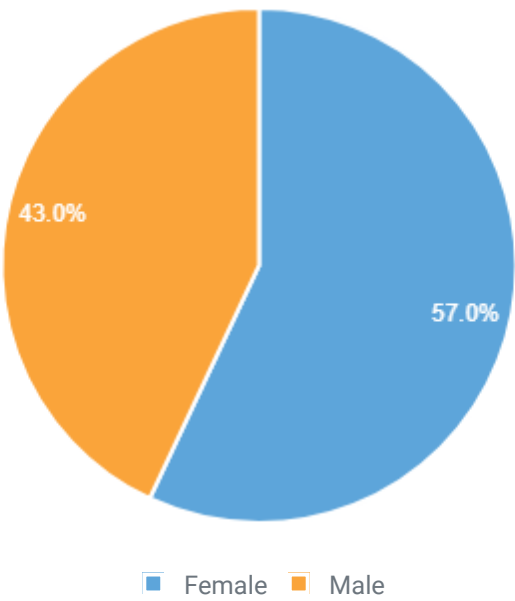
VICTIMS OF VIOLENT CRIME - AGE

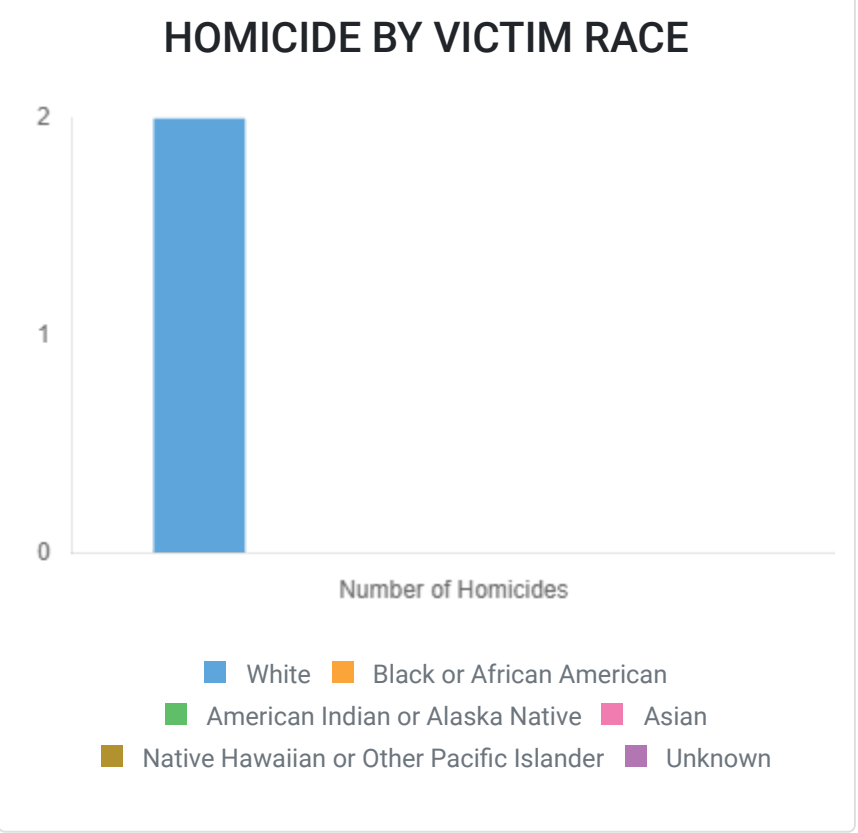
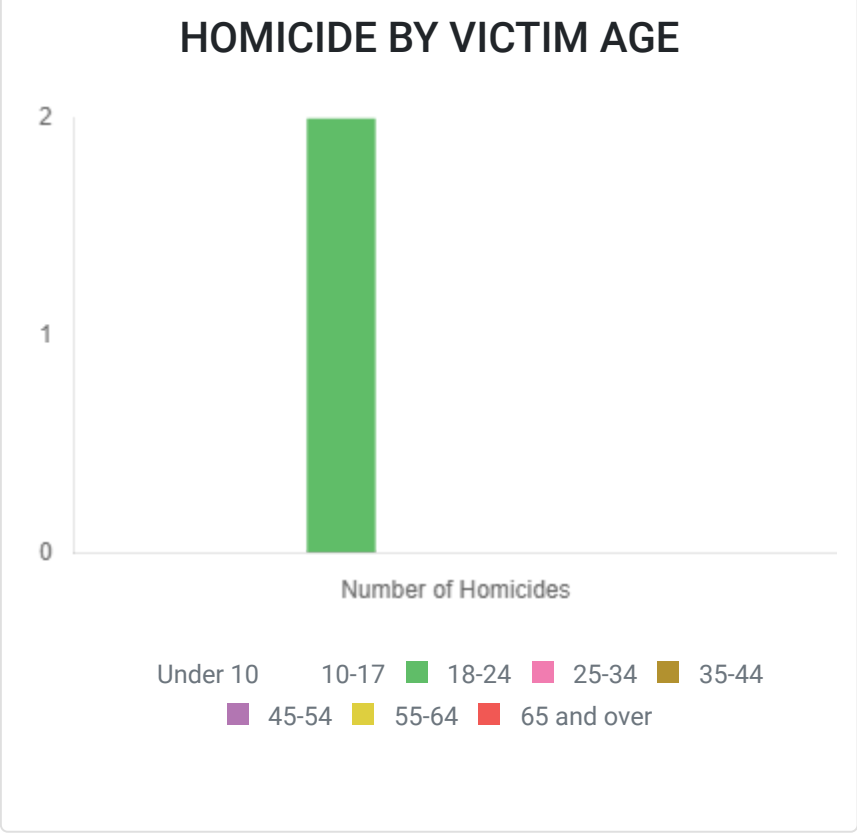
The willful (non-negligent) killing of one human being by another.

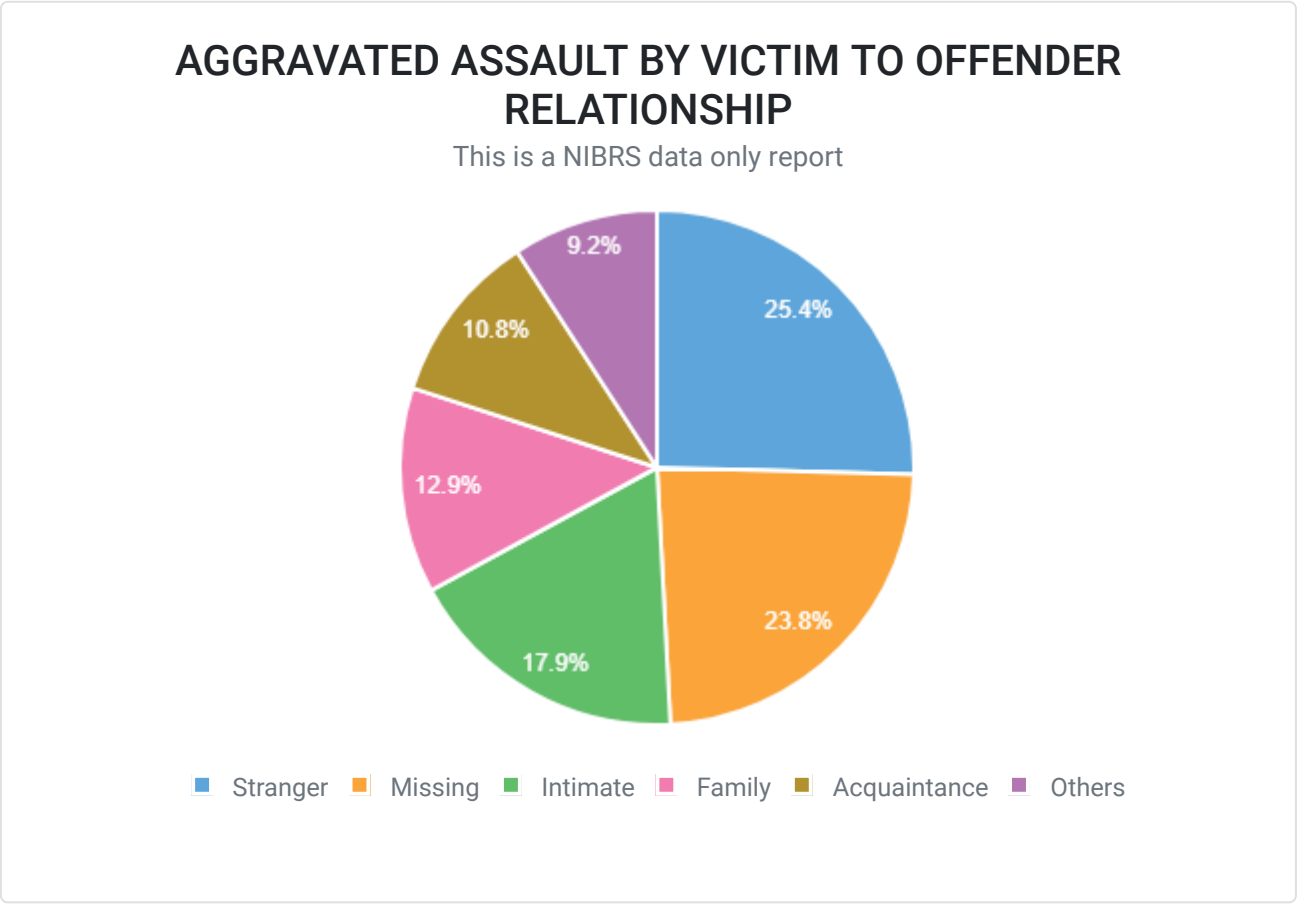
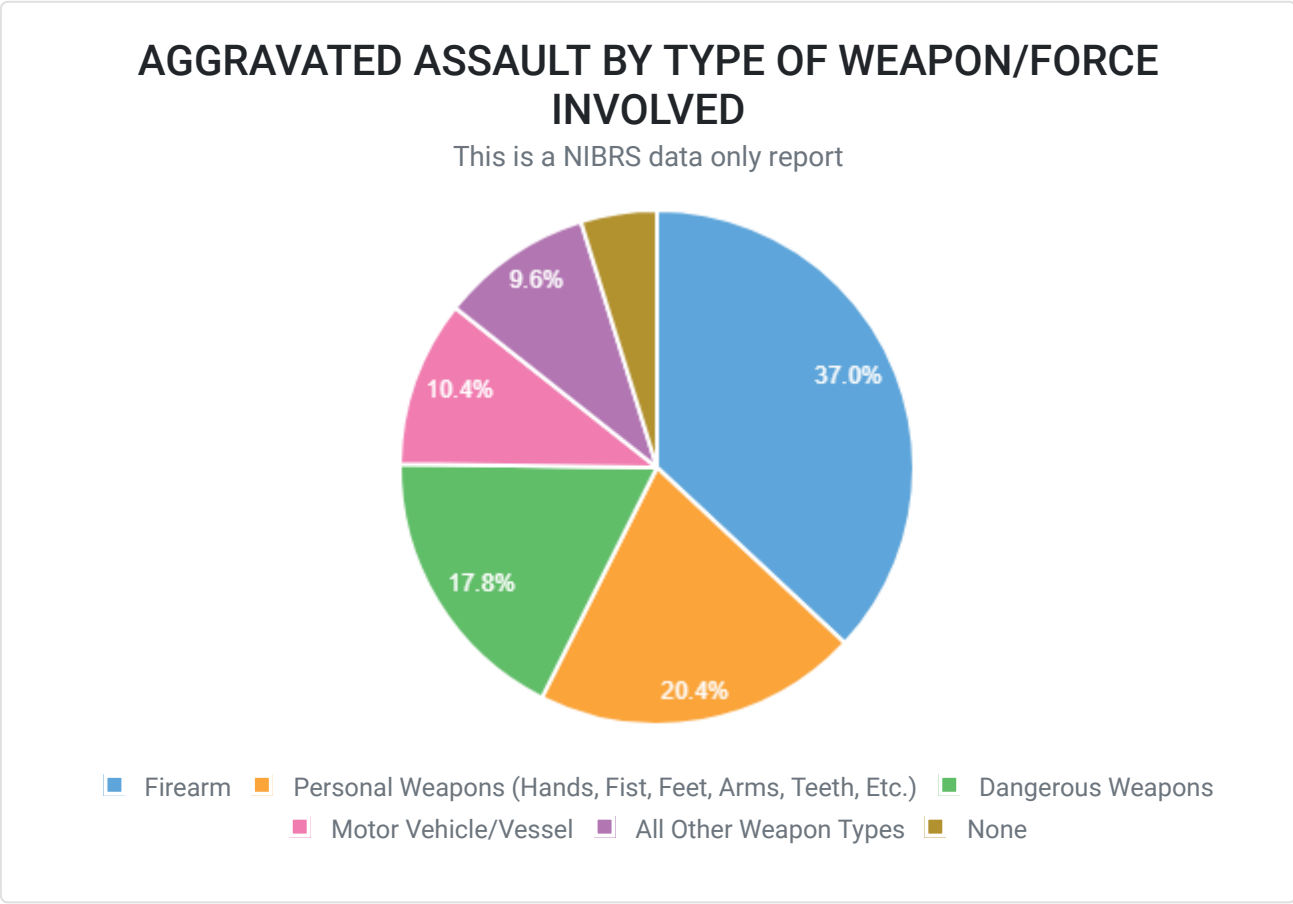
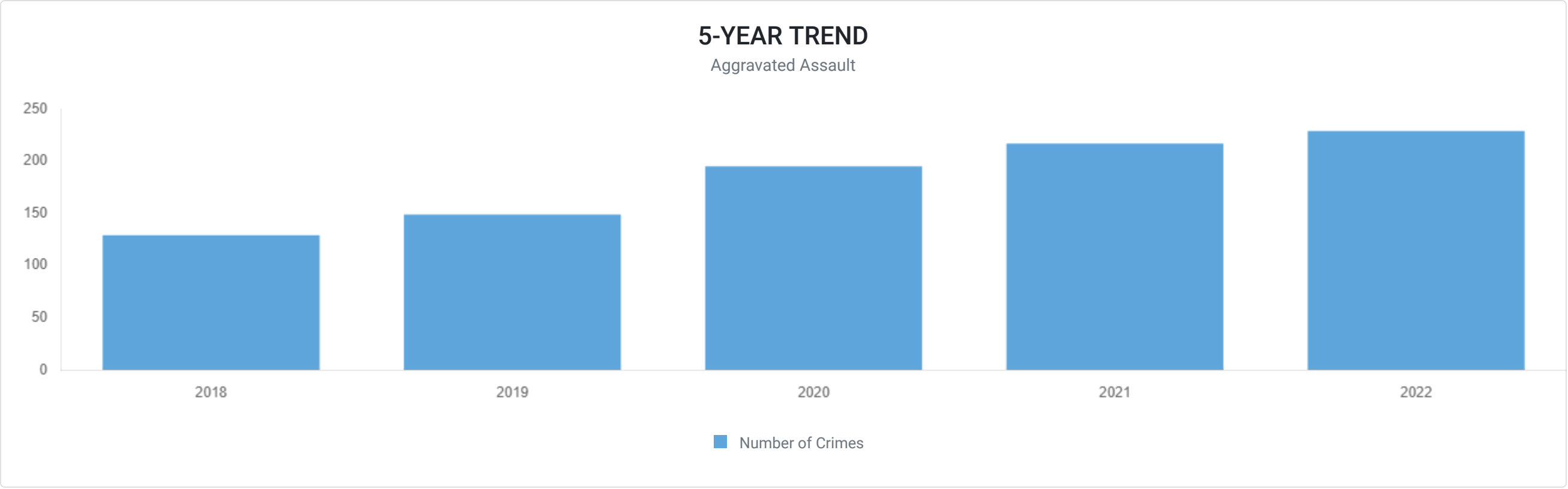
AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

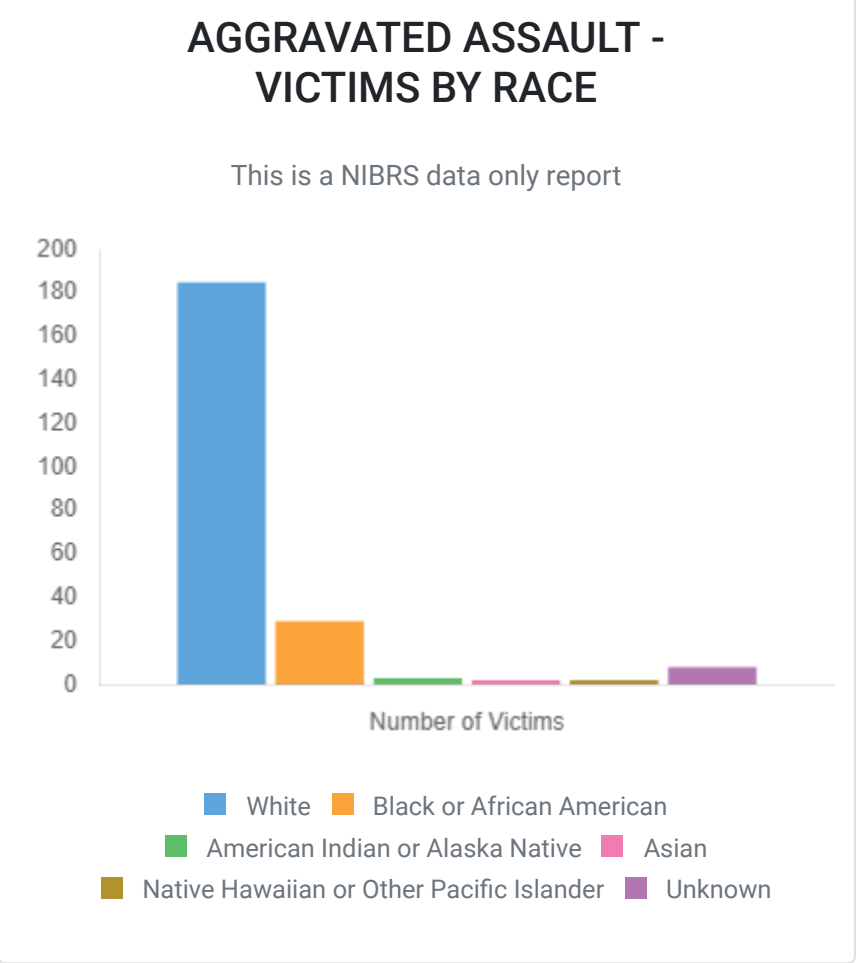
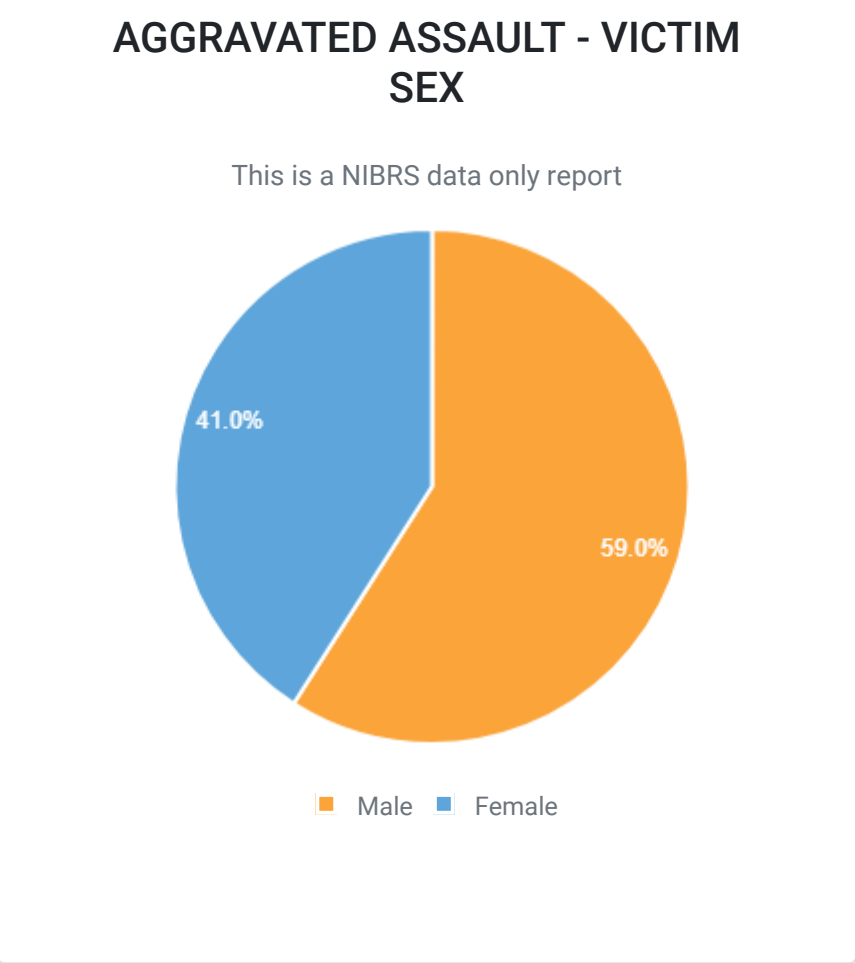
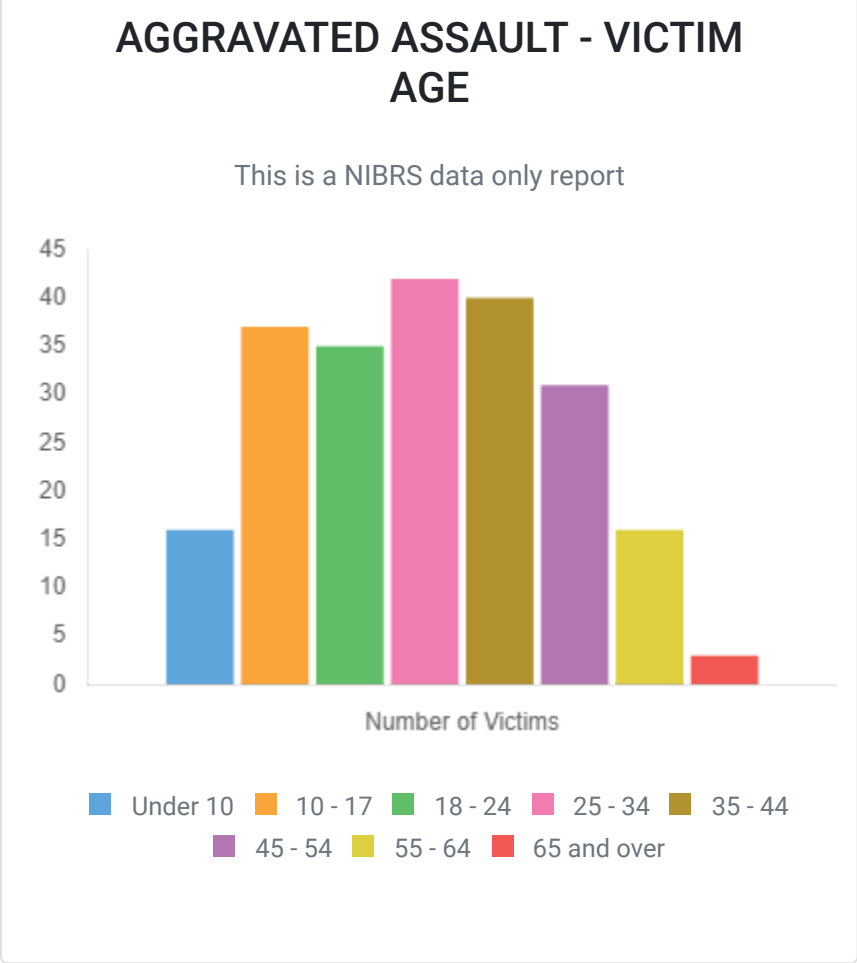
An unlawful attack by one person upon another wherein the offender uses a weapon or displays it in the threatening manner, or the victim suffers obvious severe or aggravated bodily injury involving apparent broken bones, loss of teeth, possible internal injury, severe laceration, or loss of consciousness. This also includes assault with disease (as in cases where the offender is aware that he/she is infected with a deadly disease and deliberately attempts to inflict the disease by biting, spiting, etc.).

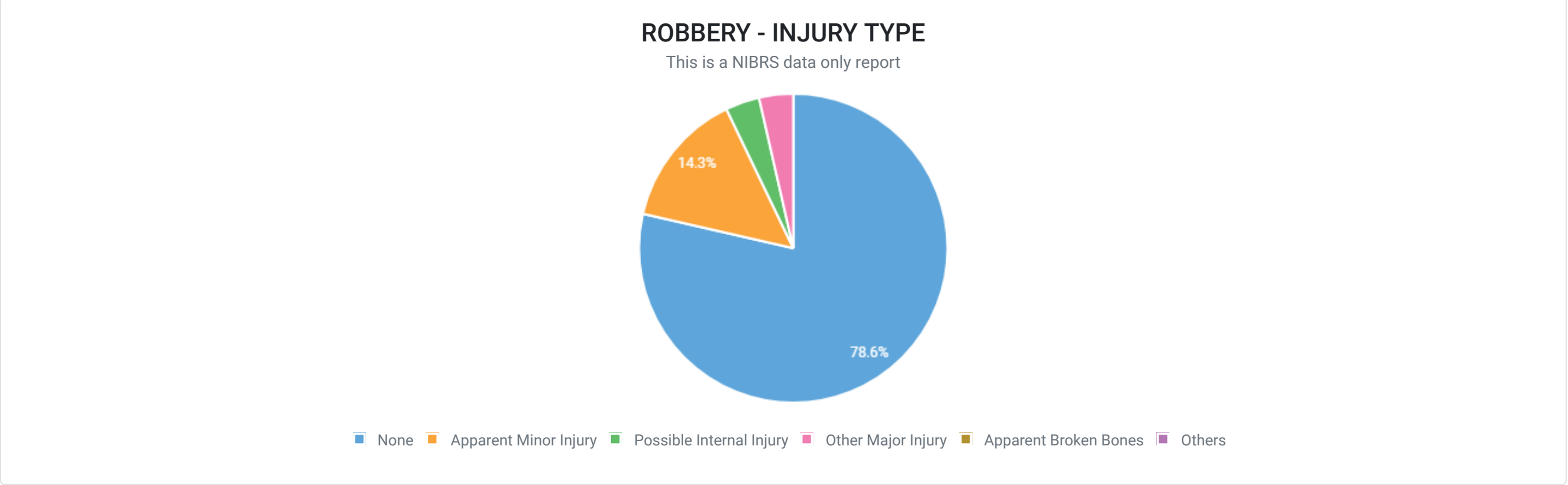
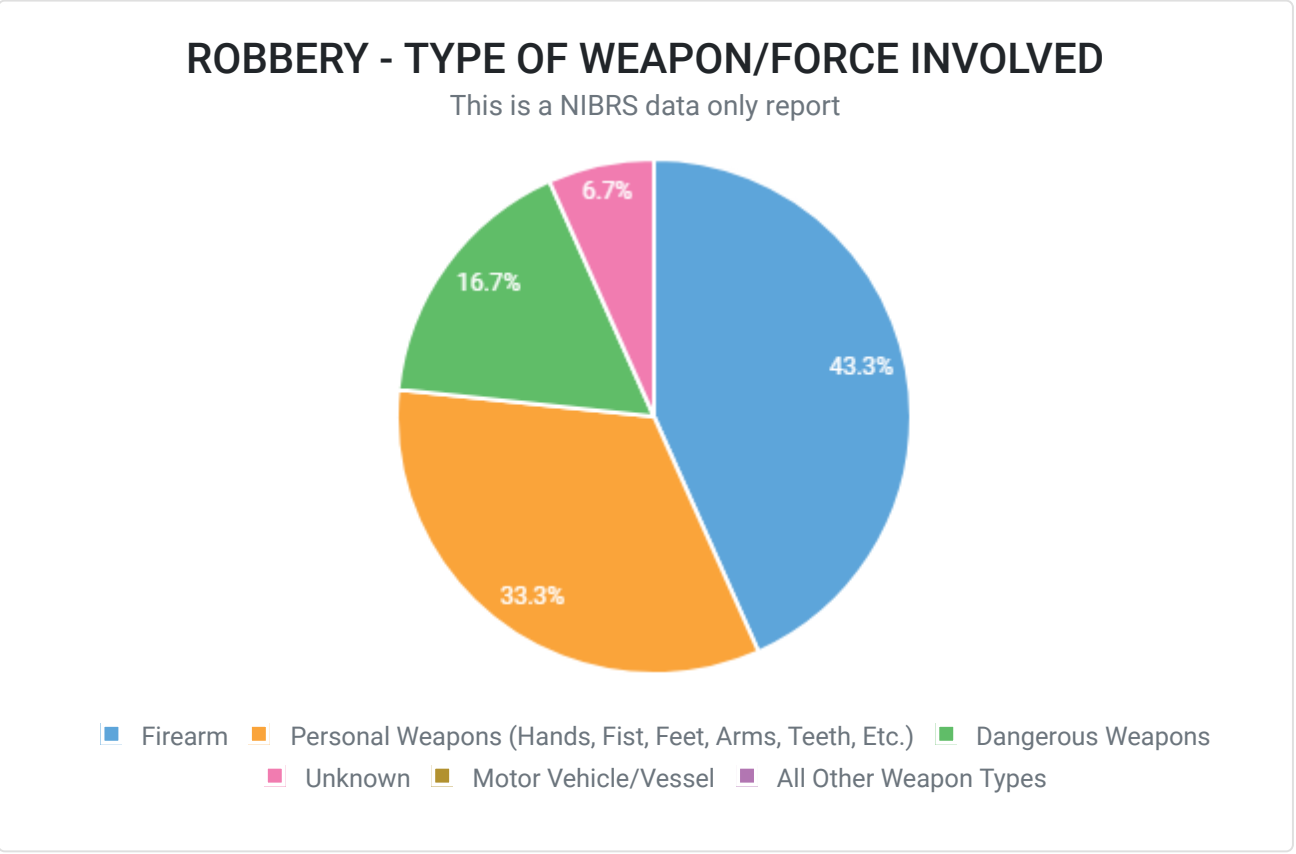
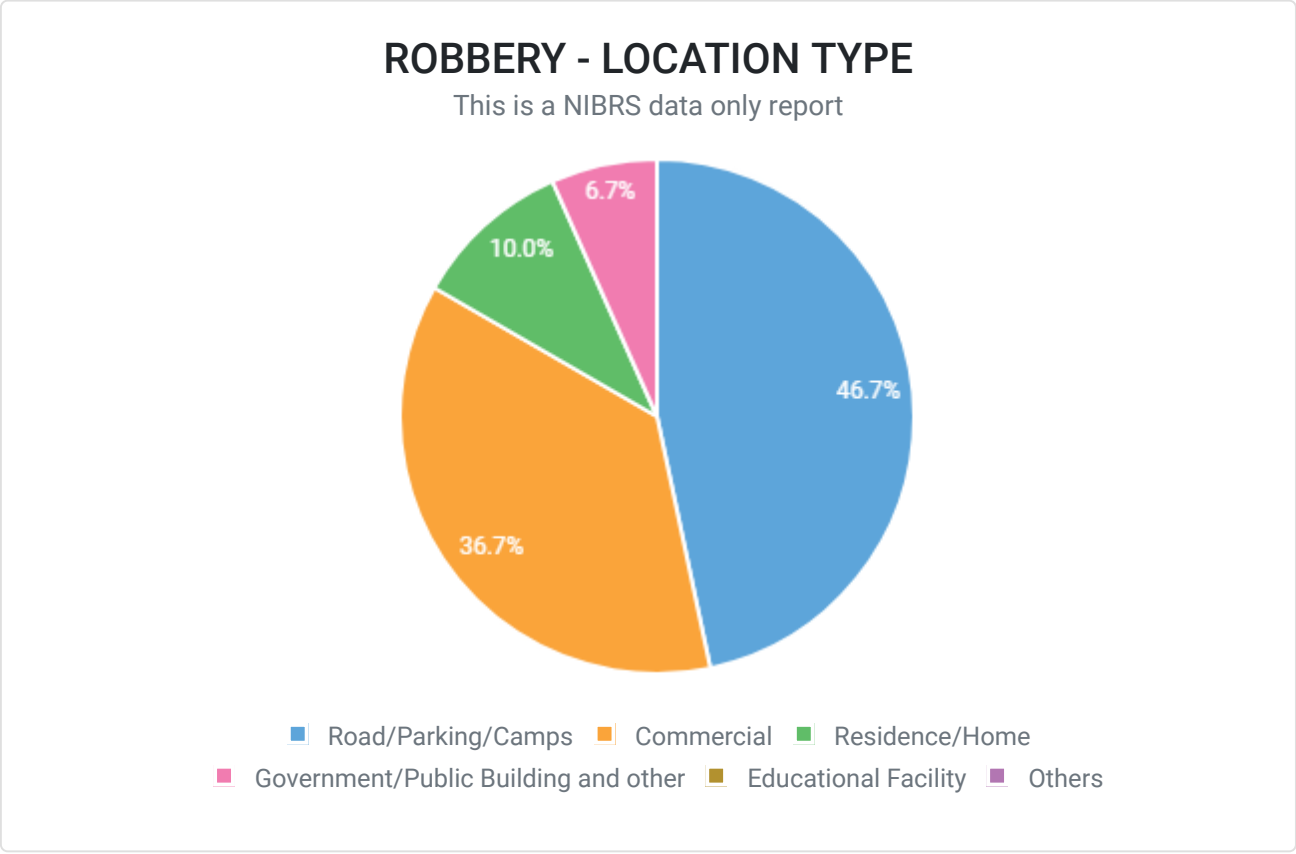


ROBBERY

The taking or attempting to take anything of value under confrontational circumstances from the control, custody, or care of another person by force or threat of force or violence and/or by putting the victim in fear of immediate harm.

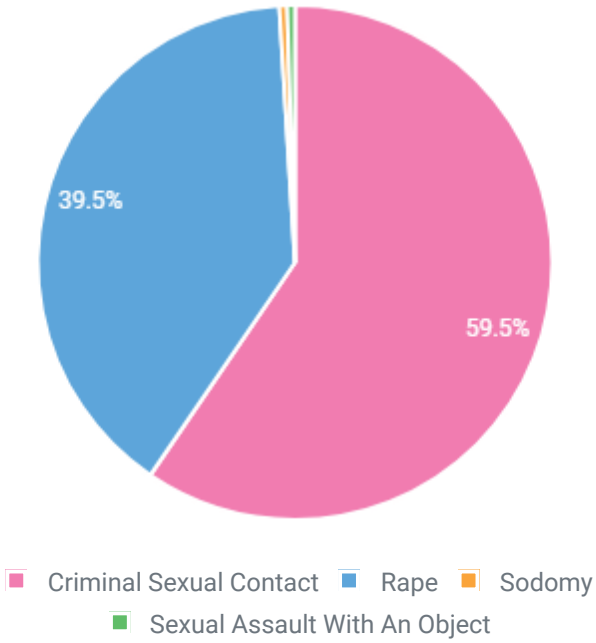

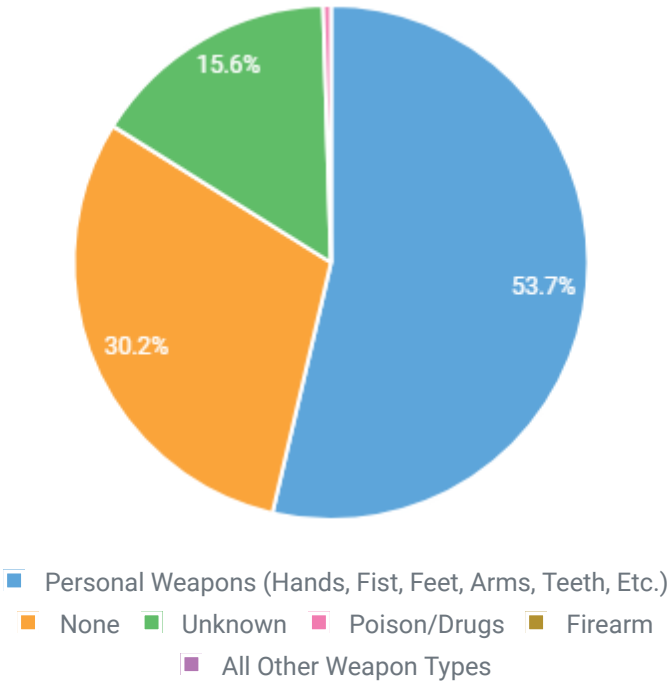
SEXUAL ASSAULT: OFFENSE TYPE

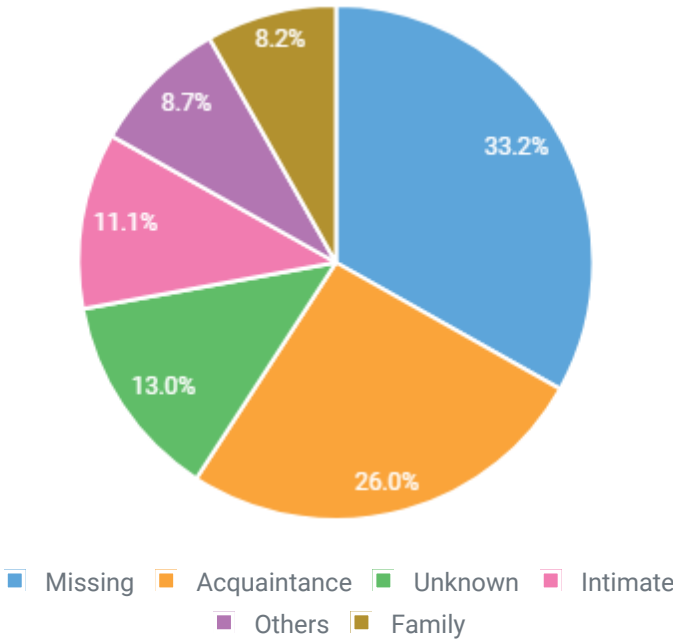
SEXUAL ASSAULT: WEAPON TYPE

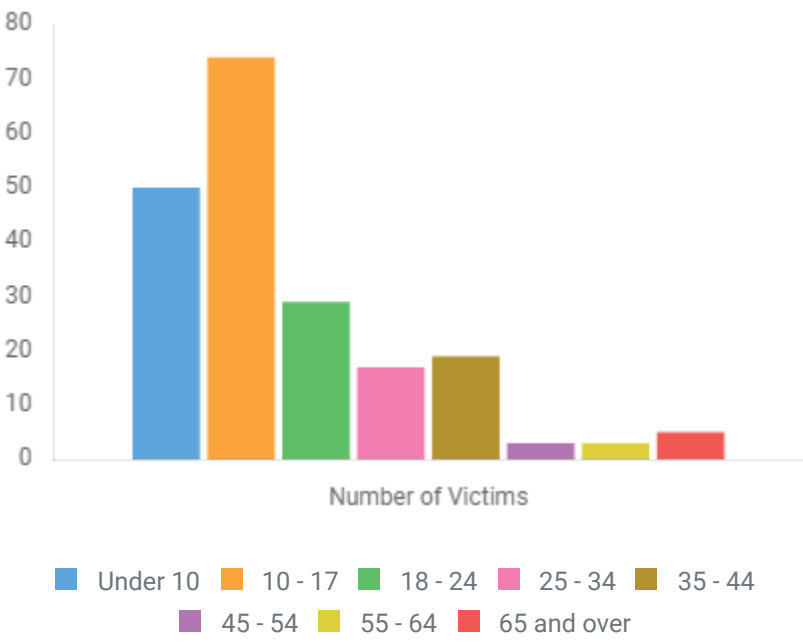
SEXUAL ASSAULT: VICTIM TO OFFENDER RELATIONSHIP

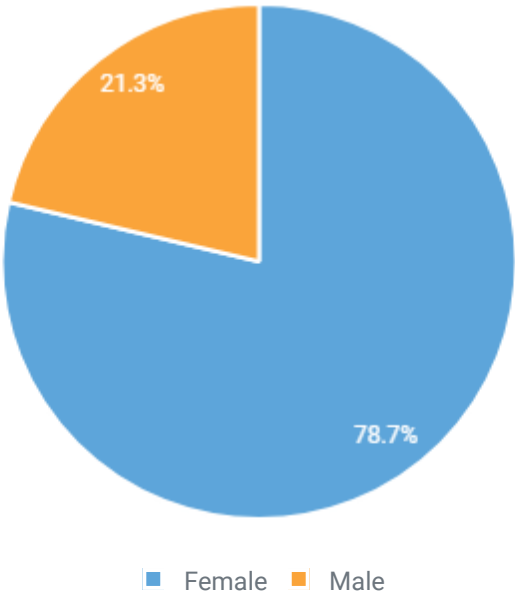
